



## **SUMMARY:**

Operate a truck and trailer or semi in a safe manner to load and deliver petroleum products to retail gas stations. It is also the driver's responsibility for the proper and efficient completion of assigned duties and operation of his or her vehicle within company policy and all governmental regulations.

## **ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Loads and unloads tanker with petroleum products adhering to all company and loading terminal, governmental regulations, and image standards.

Transports load over required route to proper destination, observing all traffic laws and safety regulations.

Chocks rear wheels of truck and trailer before any unloading takes place. Removes chocks before driving away from delivery.

Completes and transmits all paperwork in compliance with established company procedures.

Maintains vehicle cleanliness and other related articles as necessary.

Performs pre-trip & post-trip safety inspections on trucks, equipment and or facilities as required by company policy. Uphold all company safety standards.

Report any equipment malfunctions and or concerns to terminal manager and or dispatch.



**GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:**

Perform specific tasks as assigned by terminal manager or dispatch.

Give all customers prompt and courteous service and use tact and diplomacy in dealing with STL team members and customers at all times.

Promote and support company image standards.

Adhere to all city, county, state, and federal regulations.

Follow the work schedule as posted, unless a change in schedule is arranged by terminal manager or dispatch.

Stay familiar with company policies and procedures.

Ensure that the terminal manager or dispatch is made aware of any operating discrepancies.

Accurately post and verify all hours worked daily.

Works in a safe manner, at all times according to all applicable laws and to company safety manual. Report all accidents, incidents, or spills immediately.



## **QUALIFICATION REQUIREMENTS:**

Experience: Class A concurrent driving history of no less 15 months verifiable!

**\*\*This position requires (current): CDL - CLASS A with HazMat & Tanker endorsements, current DOT medical card, and clean 10 year MVR print out. Ability to obtain TWIC card required for driving positions in Oregon and Washington.**

To perform this job successfully, an individual must be able to perform each essential duty satisfactorily. The requirements listed below are representative of the knowledge, skill, and/or ability required.

## **SPECIALIZED REQUIREMENTS:**

Must provide a valid commercial driver license with hazardous material and tanker endorsement for the state in which you are applying for. Current MVR detailing driving record within company standards. Must meet Department of Transportation physical and medical requirements, pass substance abuse screening, and agree to random substance abuse screening as required by federal law and company policy.

Language and/or Communication Skills: Ability to read and comprehend simple instructions, short correspondence, and memos. Ability to write simple correspondence. Ability to speak and communicate using devices supplied by the company. Able to read and speak English sufficiently to converse with general public, understand highway traffic signs and signals in English, respond to official inquiries, and make entries on reports and records.

Mathematic Skills: Ability to add, subtract, multiply, and divide in all units of measure, using whole numbers and decimals.

Reasoning abilities: Ability to apply common sense understanding to carry out instructions furnished in written, oral, or diagram form.

Physical Demands: The physical demands described here are representative of those that must be met by a team member to successfully perform the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the team member is regularly required to sit, stand, talk, listen, and walk. The team member is required to sit in a class 8 cab for long periods of time. Other requirements include using hands and fingers to handle or feel objects, use tools, operate controls, reach with hands and arms to climb, balance, stoop, kneel, crouch, or crawl.

The team member driver must regularly lift and or move hoses and fittings that weigh up to 50 pounds and have the ability to climb steps and ladders. Team member must possess a high degree of attention and considerable dexterity in the control of a tractor trailer/bobtail as to prevent damage to property and vehicle equipment. Specific vision abilities required by this job include close vision, distance vision, peripheral vision, and the ability to adjust focus.



**JOB SPECIFIC PHYSICAL TESTS:**

Lifts/carries 50 pounds occasionally, pushing/pulling a maximum force of 75 pounds; Safe Lifting criteria, floor to knuckle 50 pounds, shoulder to overhead 50 pounds; PDC Level: heavy.

Work Environment: The work environment characteristics described here are representative of those a team member encounters while performing the essential functions of this job. While performing the duties of this job, the team member occasionally works in high, precarious places, in outside weather conditions, is occasionally exposed to fumes or airborne particles, toxic or caustic chemicals, and cold outside temperatures. The noise level in the work environment is usually moderate to high. Safety guidelines according to company handbook must be followed in the work environment at all times.
